IS STUDENT ACCOMMODATION AVAILABLE ON CAMPUS?	The Police Academy in Szczytno possesses a number of accommodation facilities available on its premises. However, due to the organisation of training and teaching process at the Academy, it is recommended for both the mobility participants and sending HEI to make arrangements concerning the accommodation and catering services in advance. If the Police Academy is not able to provide any type of accommodation at the given time, the students will be asked to find a place to stay out of the Academy premises.
WHAT IS THE AVERAGE COST OF ACCOMMODATION PER MONTH?	
WHAT IS THE APPROXIMATE COST OF LIVING PER MONTH FOR STUDENTS? (WITH RENT)	It is about 2.200,00 PLN/per month. The price includes accommodation and catering at the Academy premises and does not refer to accommodation and catering options out of the schools premises.
ARE THERE CATERING/RESTAURANT FACILITIES AVAILABLE ON CAMPUS?	Yes , there is a school canteen available.
WHAT IS THE NEAREST MAJOR CITY TO THE UNIVERSITY?	Olsztyn
WHAT IS THE DISTANCE APPROXIMATELY TO THE NEAREST CITY?	We are about 50 km away from Olsztyn
DOES THE UNIVERSITY MEET EXCHANGE STUDENTS ON ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT AND IS THERE A FEE FOR THIS?	The Police Academy in Szczytno does not provide an airport transfer for mobility students. Mobility students arrive in Szczytno at their own expense. However, at the students' request we are willing to organize a taxi transfer: Szczytno - Warsaw Aiport - Szczytno at a price of 700 – 800 PLN and Szczytno - Modlin Aiport - Szczytno at 600 PLN, which is much cheaper than taking a taxi from Warsaw. The students requesting

the service need to provide us with their flight details (date, time, number, airport).

HEALTHCARE

Free healthcare is available for EU students who possess their European Union Health Insurance Card and 1 document (ID) with identity photo. Non-EU citizens before arriving in Poland have to take out health insurance in their country of residence. The cost of a single doctor's appointment is about 100 PLN, which is to be covered by students themselves. Based on the invoice, students will be able to apply for the refund of the cost from their insurance.

ARE EXCHANGE STUDENTS COVERED BY POLICE ACADEMY'S INSURANCE

Mobility participants must have the following types of insurance: health, accident and liability. The civil liability and accident insurance should provide coverage for damages caused and suffered by the participant during his/her stay at the Police Academy in Szczytno. The insurance policy must be provided by participants or the sending institution before the mobility begins. The mobility students are also advised to be insured against the risk of the theft and loss of identification documents, travel tickets and luggage. It is not obligatory.

ARE THERE ANY FEES PAYABLE TO YOUR UNIVERSITY THAT OUR

Yes - the student's identity card - 22 PLN, accommodation and deposit fee, meals.
